



## Info about IE

- **IE Business School:** IE Business School shapes leaders who promote innovation and change in organizations, equipping directors with an entrepreneurial mindset that generates employment, wealth and social well-being.

IE Business School is regularly ranked among the top 10 business schools by media like Bloomberg Businessweek, Financial Times, The Wall Street Journal and The Economist, who consider IE's flagship International MBA and Executive MBA programs, available in both English and Spanish; as among the best in the world.

IE Business School has an urban campus in Madrid and a faculty of more than 400 professors, 100 of them full-time, who teach students from more than 100 countries in its master, PhD and executive education programs.

- **IE Law School:** In the field of law, IE Law School has a long tradition of teaching LL.M. Programs such as LL.M.s in Spanish Business Law and Tax Law; both offered in Spanish, and the English programs International LL.M., and the Executive LL.M.; which is a dual degree offered in collaboration with Northwestern University School of Law.
- **IE University:** IE University offers undergraduate and graduate programs in English and Spanish that are designed and implemented in compliance with the European Higher Education Area. The student body comprises 65% international students from 75 different nationalities. The University portfolio includes the Bachelor in Business Administration (BBA), the Bachelor of Laws (LL.B.), and Dual Degree in Business Administration and Law, as well as Bachelor and Master Programs in Communication, International Relations, Architecture and Psychology.
- **Entrepreneurial Culture:** Founded by entrepreneurs, the entrepreneurial vein runs deep at IE, where business creation is seen as an engine for growth, value generation, employment and social well-being.  
All IE students design business plans during the program with the help of a team comprising over 200 external tutors from the business community. Students may also opt for the Social Entrepreneurship Track, a specialization whereby MBA participants pursue a career as a social entrepreneur. Some 25% of IE Business School MBA graduates set up their own companies.
- **International Focus:** The diversity and international focus of our faculty, student body and research is something we are truly proud of. This year 7,800 students of more than 90 different nationalities, 35% of which are women, will attend our campus. This commitment to working with and understanding diversity ensures that participants are truly prepared for the challenges of working in multi-cultural environments. The result is a highly international program content, and a faculty and student body that comprises a veritable cultural melting pot.
